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What's Happening

New E-Prescribing Legislation that May Affect Your Practice

Effective January 1, 2022, <u>Senate Bill 0166 (CH0299)/House Bill 0512 (CH0230) (2020) Drugs and Devices –</u> <u>Electronic Prescriptions – Controlled Dangerous Substances</u> requires licensed healthcare providers in Maryland to electronically prescribe prescriptions for controlled dangerous substances. This legislation is in scope for dental providers.

Health General Article 21-220(C) provides exceptions to this requirement and the requirement to request a waiver. We encourage you and your practice to review this legislation and determine which steps, if any, need to be taken. You can find more information by clicking <u>here</u>.

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Coding & Reimbursement

New Updates to Dental Clinical Resources

CareFirst has updated our Dental Clinical Criteria and our Reference Guide for Required Attachments to accommodate CDT changes for 2023.

Updates include:

Dental Clinical Criteria

- Added specific criteria that identifies the types of extractions being performed and submitted for payment. *Determination of type of extraction depends primarily on the anatomic position of the tooth/remnants as well as the technique required to remove the tooth/remnants.*
- Updated frenectomy CDT codes.
- Added D7950 to allow for sedation and general anesthesia benefits for this procedure.
- Advised that new CDT code D4286 for removal of a non-resorbable barrier membrane is a periodontal category code, but is to be used whenever a non-resorbable barrier is being removed (endo and implant osseous surgeries).

Reference Guide for Required Attachments

- Clarified that any time there is a tooth that has had endodontic treatment, a periapical film that demonstrates the full length of the tooth with the gutta percha fill completed is required.
- Emphasized that for periodontal surgical treatments, all pre-surgical preparatory treatment, e.g., root planing, is included in the narrative.
- Advised that if overdentures are treatment planned to be supported by implants, be sure to have a full length diagnostic radiographic image of the implant in place and integrated.
- Clarified that repairs related to the peri-implant structures require periodontal charting as part of the required attachments, as well as history leading up to the current treatments of the implant and surrounding structures.

In compliance with state regulations and accrediting bodies, CareFirst requires all practitioners in each provider group to complete our recredentialing process every three years.

CareFirst encourages the use of the Council for Affordable Quality Healthcare (CAQH) ProView® application. CAQH ProView is an online credentialing application that streamlines data collection by using a standard form. New practitioners can go directly to CAQH ProView and complete the application through the CAQH ProView secure website. Existing providers may use this portal to log in and ensure their information is up to date.
