Magellan's program offerings include:

PROGRAM	PROGRAM BENEFITS
Care Management	 The personal care management program gives patients one-on-one support through specialty-trained and licensed behavior health care coordinators who can: help them understand their prescribed treatment, recommend health services, community services and resources for support, and develop an individualized plan of action to track their progress with all those involved in their care.
My Care Link Up	 The My Care Link Up program connects patients to a Magellan representative who can: find a behavioral health provider that best meets their individualized needs, schedule appointments at timeframes convenient for them, and follow up after the appointment to assess their satisfaction with the services they received.
Magellan Telehealth	 The Telehealth program allows patients and their behavioral health provider to have real-time, two-way communication through an online virtual appointment, at a place and time convenient for them. Patients still experience a 'face-to-face' visit through a secure, private connection for needs like follow up care, counseling, and medication help.
At Risk Adolescents	 This program provides assistance for parents or caregivers who are concerned about the behavior of their teen or young adult. Clinicians are available by phone and can help: complete an assessment of the concerning behavior, refer the adolescent to a Behavioral Health Care Coordinator or to a community resource who can recommend individual or family therapy, or direct patients to online educational materials.
Medication-Assisted Therapy (MAT) For Alcohol and Drug Dependence	 The MAT program gives patients medication treatment options if they need extra help managing their addiction while on the road to recovery. The program not only focuses on patients who have been discharged from inpatient substance use treatment programs, but also targets individuals receiving outpatient case or disease management services.
